*22. **Proposed Regulation Amendment Workshop** – The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topics that may be addressed in the proposed regulations.

1. **Amendment of Nevada Administrative Code 639.707 Counseling of patients: Duties of pharmacist or intern pharmacist; documentation.** Makes changes to the requirement that a pharmacist or intern pharmacist counsel a patient regarding his or her prescription.
2. **Amendment of Nevada Administrative Code 639.NEW** Adds new language to allow for the use of a mechanical device by a dispensing practitioner.

*23. Notice of Intent to Act Upon a Regulation:

1. **Amendment of Nevada Administrative Code 639.5007 Pharmacy License Changes** Text from 1(a) through 6(e) will be repealed. New language will allow the Board to place conditions upon the granting of license for pharmacy under certain circumstances and ensure that the licensure is used only to conduct legitimate pharmacy practice.
2. **Amendment of Nevada Administrative Code 639.NEW Positive Identification of User of Pharmacy Computer Systems.** This language requires a person using the pharmacy computer to be identified by a unique identifier.
