## LEARNING OBJECTIVES

Nevada Pharmacy Law (0.1 CEU)

1. Apply pharmacy laws regarding expiration date labeling requirements for prescriptions dispensed in the community setting.
2. Describe requirements for ordering schedule II drug products.
3. Identify situations in which information in a schedule II prescription can be legally changed.
4. Identify legal requirements for counseling of patients upon dispensing prescriptions.
5. Describe the applicable laws regarding the transfer of prescriptions between pharmacies.
6. Identify proper procedures for notifying the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy for address and employment changes.
7. Identify the proper procedures for handling electronic prescriptions.
8. Identify the proper procedures for the storage of refrigerated prescription products.

**Target audience:** Pharmacists and technicians practicing in Nevada who wish to meet their law-specific CE requirements. The program will primarily focus on community pharmacy practice.
