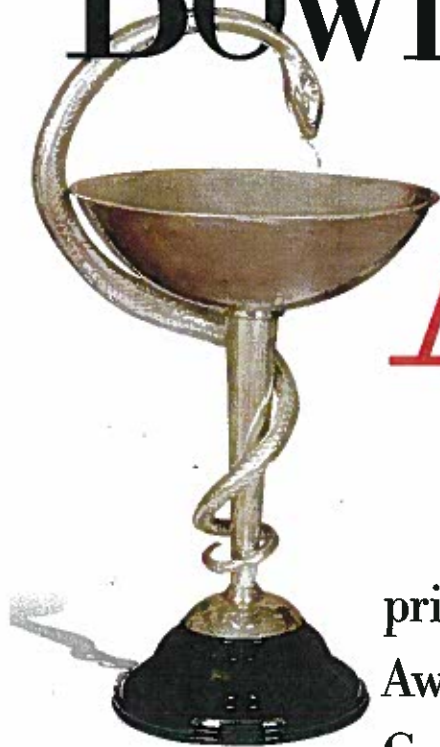


BOWL OF HYGEIA
