AGREED BOARD ORDER #T-08-548

RE: IN THE MATTER OF GABRIEL V. CASTANEDA (PHARMACY TECHNICIAN REGISTRATION #144317) BEFORE THE TEXAS STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY

On this day came on to be considered by the Texas State Board of Pharmacy (hereinafter referred to as "TSBP") the matter of pharmacy technician registration number 144317 issued to Gabriel V. Castaneda (hereinafter referred to as "Respondent").

The TSBP gave preliminary notice to Respondent of its intent to take disciplinary action with respect to Respondent's pharmacy technician registration as a result of information received by the TSBP which produced evidence indicating that Respondent may have violated:

Section 568.002(a) and Section 568.003(a)(1) and (7) of the Texas Pharmacy Act, Tex. Occ. Code Ann. Subtitle J (2007); and

Section 297.3(a)(1) and (c) of the Texas Pharmacy Rules of Procedure, 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE (2008), in that allegedly:

COUNT

Beginning in January 2007, through on or about July 22, 2008, Gabriel Castaneda, while acting as an employee at Target Store #T-1506, 3909 East 42nd Street, Odessa, Texas 79762, was unlawfully engaged in the duties of a pharmacy technician. Mr. Castaneda failed to register with the Texas State Board of Pharmacy before starting his employment as a pharmacy technician. As evidenced by pharmacy records, Mr. Castaneda engaged in the duties of a pharmacy technician (or pharmacy technician trainee) without a registration until his failure to register was discovered during a Texas State Board of Pharmacy inspection on July 22, 2008.

On or about February 10, 2007, Mr. Castaneda filed an application with the Texas State Board of Pharmacy to register as a pharmacy technician. Mr. Castaneda's application was approved and he was cleared to continue the registration process on March 6, 2007, however, after failing to pay, his application became incomplete on May 5, 2007. On or about August 28, 2008, Mr. Castaneda re-filed an application with the Texas State Board of Pharmacy to register as a pharmacy technician.

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Respondent was notified that the matters previously set out in this Order could be disposed of without the scheduling of an informal conference or a formal administrative hearing. By Respondent's signature on this Order, Respondent neither admits nor denies the truth of the matters previously set out in this Order, agrees that the TSBP has jurisdiction in this matter and waives Respondent's right to informal conference, to notice of hearing, to a formal administrative hearing, and to judicial review of this Order.

Respondent understands that any failure to comply with the terms of this Order is a basis for discipline under the Texas Pharmacy Act.

Should this Order not be accepted by the TSBP, it is agreed that neither the presentation of the Order to the TSBP, nor the TSBP's consideration of the Order, will be deemed to have unfairly or illegally prejudiced the TSBP or its individual members and, therefore, will not be grounds for precluding the TSBP or any individual member of the TSBP from further participation in proceedings related to the matters set forth in the Order.

Respondent agrees to the entry of an Order disposing of the need for further disciplinary action in this matter and further agrees to comply with the terms and conditions set forth in the ORDER OF THE BOARD below.

ORDER OF THE BOARD

THEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the TSBP does hereby ORDER that Respondent shall pay an administrative penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) due ninety (90) days after the entry of this Order.

If Respondent fails to pay the administrative penalty within ninety (90) days after the entry of this Order, pharmacy technician registration number 144317 issued to

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Respondent shall be suspended, effective ninety (90) days after the entry of this Order, until such payment is received by the BOARD. In the event that pharmacy technician registration number 144317 issued to Respondent is suspended Respondent shall not practice as a pharmacy technician in this state or be employed in this state in any manner that would allow access to prescription drugs.

If within six (6) months after the entry of this Order, Respondent fails to pay the administrative penalty, pharmacy technician registration number 144317 issued to Respondent shall be revoked and of no further force and effect, effective six (6) months after the entry of this Order. In the event that pharmacy technician registration number 144317 issued to Respondent is revoked, Respondent shall:

- (a) not practice as a pharmacy technician in this state or be employed in this state in any manner that would allow access to prescription drugs during the period pharmacy technician registration number 144317 is revoked; and
- (b) surrender to the BOARD, pharmacy technician registration number 144317 and any renewal certificate and personal identification card pertaining to pharmacy technician registration number 144317.

It is finally ORDERED that failure to comply with any of the terms and conditions in this Order constitutes a violation of the pharmacy laws or rules of this state and shall be grounds for further disciplinary action against the Texas technician registration held by Respondent.

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And it is so ORDERED.
