Nevada Prescription Monitoring Program

How does the NV PMP work?

Healthcare providers access the NV PMP through a secure, web-based application to request patient prescription history reports. The website is available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

Who is allowed access to the NV PMP?

Healthcare providers authorized to prescribe or dispense controlled substances including, physicians, dentists, advanced practitioners of nursing, physician assistants and pharmacists are eligible to register for direct on-line access to the NV PMP.

How do I register for access to the NV PMP?

Go to the NV PMP website at <https://nevada.pmpaware.net>.

Click "Create an account".

Enter your email and a password.

Select Healthcare Professional and your specific role (ex: Physician or Pharmacist). Click "Update User Roles and Continue".

Enter your demographic information. Required fields are marked with a red asterisk.

Check your email for further instructions.

1. You will receive an email verification. Open the email and click on the link within the email. If the email has expired, click the link to have a new email verification link sent. Then click on the link in the new email.
2. You will receive a second email with a validation document. The completed document can be uploaded or faxed to the number on the form.

After the online demographic information is provided, the email is verified and the validation document is received, your account will be activated.
