ACTIVITIES REPORT

MAY 31-JUNE 1, 2017 BOARD MEETING HELD IN RENO, NEVADA

This report is prepared and presented to keep interested legislators and others abreast of the activities of the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy. Following is a summary of the May/June, 2017 Board meeting.

Licensing Activity:

- 7 licenses were granted for Out-of-State MDEG (Medical Devices, Equipment and Gases) companies and 2 granted for Nevada MDEG companies.
- 24 licenses were granted for Out-of-State pharmacies, pending receipt of a favorable inspection for all compounding pharmacies.
- 18 licenses were granted for Out-of-State wholesalers, and 1 license was granted for a Nevada wholesaler.
- 6 licenses were granted for Nevada pharmacies.
- 1 application was granted for a Nevada wholesaler.

Disciplinary Actions:

- Pharmacist JN was fined \$5000 & licensed suspended (both stayed); ordered 10 additional hours of CE; was placed on probation; must engage & participate in an Affiliated Monitors program; and cannot be a PIC for multiple pharmacy violations including record keeping issues and poor compounding of prescriptions. Pharmacist MC was fined \$750 plus admin fees & ordered 2 additional hours of CE for his role in the case. Pharmacy SV was fined \$10K and was suspended (both stayed until Affiliated Monitors requirement is satisfied). Similar discipline was ordered for another case involving the same pharmacist and pharmacy.
- Physician DJ was fined \$6800 (stayed) and put on probation for failure to sign several CII prescriptions ordered on an emergency basis.
- Pharmaceutical technician LS was revoked for diversion of controlled substances for personal

Other Activity:

- The usual Board business reports were given, including recent and future speaking engagements; reports on national meetings; and collaboration with other state agencies.
- A discussion was held regarding veterinary drug delivery systems.
- The budget for fiscal 2017-2018 was presented and approved.
- The annual Board staff personnel review was conducted.
