My name is Dustin Godoy and I am an upcoming P1 student at Roseman University. Earlier this year (April 4, 2020) I was arrested for DUI (alcohol related). On the night of April 4, 2020, I made the incredibly selfish decision to get behind the wheel while intoxicated, I had a few drinks and felt the need to get some food at the In-n-Out located on Serene Avenue and Eastern Avenue. On my way back home, I failed to maintain my lane and accidentally collided into my neighbor's trailer, this occurred heading east on Pescara Court, less than one minute away from my home. Fifteen minutes after the collision, a police officer arrives on scene to assess the situation. The police officer asks if I had been drinking that night to which I answer yes. I was then brought to the Clark County Detention Center and my blood was drawn to evaluate my blood alcohol content to which I am still awaiting the results.

I have no excuses for my actions, I made a poor decision and I am still trying to cope with the situation. My actions performed that night are by no means reconcilable. No one was hurt or injured in the accident and I thank God for keeping those around me safe from the harm I could have potentially inflicted upon them that night. I continue to thank God for watching over those around me on that very night. The only way I can cope with the situation is by trying to move forward and to improve myself. Since the accident I have not had a sip of alcohol and will not do so going forward.

Currently I am still going through the legal motions, my first court appearance was scheduled for June 4, 2020 but has been pushed back until December 10, 2020. At this point in time, I have been arrested for DUI but have not been charged or convicted of a crime. If granted the pharmacy intern license, I will be sure to keep the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy, as well as Roseman University updated with the legal proceedings as they occur. I will also be sure to

provide all documentation pertaining to the situation to the Board of Pharmacy and Roseman University when I receive said documentation (blood test results, etc.).

I respectfully ask the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy to not deny my pharmacy intern application. I do recognize that the mistake I made in April is detrimental to my character but I respectfully ask the Board of Pharmacy to not judge my character based solely on this particular instance. If granted the pharmacy intern license, I willfully oblige myself to random blood tests to ensure the Board of Pharmacy, as well as Roseman University of my sobriety. In the event that my blood tests do not yield a negative result, I will surrender my pharmacy intern license.

I have worked incredibly hard to get to this point in my life. I want to set a good example for my niece and nephews; I want to prove to them that dedication, hard work and patience gets you to where you want to be in life. Please consider the approval of my pharmacy intern application, denial of my application would be very devastating to my loved ones. Denial of my application would also result in the automatic loss of my seat and I will be dropped from the program that I worked extremely hard to get into. If granted the opportunity to appear before the board to explain the situation in greater detail and to also take the opportunity to express my deepest regrets for my actions, I would greatly appreciate it.


