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#### NEVADA STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY

#### **ACTIVITIES REPORT**

#### DECEMBER 6, 2017 BOARD MEETING HELD IN RENO, NEVADA

This report is prepared and presented to keep interested legislators and others abreast of the activities of the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy. Following is a summary of the December, 2017 Board meeting.

#### **Licensing Activity:**

- 14 licenses were granted for Out-of-State MDEG (Medical Devices, Equipment and Gases) companies and 1 granted for Nevada MDEG companies.
- 25 licenses were granted for Out-of-State pharmacies; pending receipt of a favorable inspection for all compounding pharmacies.
- 17 licenses were granted for Out-of-State wholesalers.
- 2 licenses were granted for Nevada pharmacies.
- Probation was removed for pharmacist DJ after demonstrating successful rehab.
- Pharmacist JS was approved for renewal with conditions

#### **Disciplinary Actions:**

Pharmacist ES was suspended with the suspension stayed and 12 months' probation for refilling two different strengths of the same drug for over 5 months, causing alleged patient harm. She was further ordered 4 hours of CE and \$3500 in fines. Pharmacist HW was fined \$750 for refilling these two prescriptions once. Pharmacy CV was fined \$1500 and ordered to certify training to prevent further such incidents.

#### Other Activity:

- The usual Board business reports were given, including recent and future speaking engagements; reports on national meetings; and collaboration with other state agencies.
- A presentation was made by James Wilson, MD on antimicrobial resistance in Nevada.
- The annual outside audit was presented by Kohn & Company.

#### Workshop:

1. Amendment of Nevada Administrative Code Chapter 639 to add a new section thereto providing for the dispensing of dangerous drugs by veterinarians through consignment. To allow a veterinarian to take legal ownership but not physical possession of a dangerous drug from a wholesaler, prescribe the drug to a patient, and then consign to a pharmacy for dispensing to the patient.

#### Public Hearing:

- 1. Amendment of Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 639.926: A regulation relating to the transmission of information to the Prescription Monitoring Program. Definition of Days' Supply and Addition of ICD-10 Code (International Classification of Diseases Tenth Revision). Adding Schedule V drugs to the list of controlled substances that must be reported to the Prescription Monitoring Program. (LCB File No. R045-17)
- 2. Amendment of Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 453.440: Changes to Components of a Written Prescription.(LCB File No. R046-17)
