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Partial Waiver of Certain Restrictions on the Services which may be Performed by Pharmaceutical Technicians in Hospitals in Response to COVID-19

March 29, 2020

To promote patient access to pharmaceutical care in hospitals during the COVID-19 outbreak, the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy has partially waived certain restrictions on the services which may be performed by pharmaceutical technicians in hospitals. *See* NAC 639.245.

This partial waiver is being issued in accordance with NAC 639.170.

A pharmaceutical technician under the direct supervision of a pharmacist may administer a controlled substance or dangerous drug to a patient in a hospital pursuant to a written hospital policy by the following methods:

- Orally; and
- Topically.

NOTE: The Board will not be approving policies, procedures, or technology solutions, but a hospital pharmacy should be able to justify how the policies, procedures, or technology meets the requirements of this partial waiver.

This partial waiver is in effect until January 31, 2021.
