

NVBOP – Single and Multi-Dose Containers

- If a single dose or multi-dose container is breached then the date of the breach must be marked on the container.
- Open single use ampules shall not be store for any time period.

Single Dose Containers – After the breach of the seal:

- May be used within 1 hour after the breach of the seal if: The breach occurred in an area of air quality worse than ISO Class 5 and the container is subsequently stored in an environment with an air quality that is worse than ISO Class 7.
- May be used within 6 hours after the breach of the seal if: The breach occurred and the contents were used in an environment with an air quality that equals or exceeds ISO Class 5 and the container is subsequently stored in an environment with an air quality that equals or exceeds ISO Class 7.
- May be used within 24 hours after the breach of the seal if: The breach occurred in an environment with air quality that equals or exceeds ISO Class 5 and the container remains in an environment with an air quality that equals or exceeds ISO Class 5.

Multi-Dose Containers – After the breach of the seal:

- Must be stored according to the requirements of the manufacturer.
- Contents of the container may be used within 28 days.
- Both the opened date and the beyond use date must be listed on the container.
