The following is the details surrounding my DEA license investigation.

In August 2011 while working at General Electric Transportation Occupational Health as a Physician Assistant I was asked to report to Human Resources. I was met by my Supervising Physician Dr. Timothy Ward and the legal department. They had inquired about my recent prescription activity, of which I confirmed that I had called in a prescription for Hydrocodone 10/325mg. I was then terminated from the position. I was then contacted by DEA agent Lewis Colosimo and Agent Alan McGill. I had cooperated fully with their requests. I had voluntarily surrendered my DEA license. I had enrolled in a rehabilitation program as per their request. I had complied with abstention from pain medication and ETOH. I was monitored for compliance and completed the program without incident. The DEA office had investigated and I had called in a supplication prescription 4 times in 2 years for pain management. I had discussed my pain control for chronic low back pain and severe left ankle osteoarthritis with my PCP and orthopedist requesting additional HCD for pain control needed while going on vacation: hiking/camping and theme parks. The DEA had required me to attend Chronic Pain management CME course, which I did, and my DEA license was reissued approximately 6 months later. I then worked in pain management at Advance Pain Management for a year without incident. I am currently working in Las Vegas as a Chronic Pain Specialist.

Citation: 7/25/2012 Misdemeanor: Simple Assault

On July 25, 2012 I was working as a Mixed Martial Arts instructor. On that day I had begun teaching, a potential student, actually the son of an old neighbor, was periodically attending classes and was thinking of becoming a paying student. He had joined us warming up for class. Almost immediately he and another adult student were verbally arguing. I had to repeatedly tell them to stop and perform the exercises. As we continued he had approached me confrontationally and wanted to spar. Sparring, as he and I had done so before, requires additional pads, protective gear and preparation, it is a form of practice fighting. I had told him that we are working on pad work. He began to swing punches at me, striking and cutting me over the left eye. I took him down to the mat and advised him to follow my instructions. He rejoined the class after 15 minutes and again approached me wanting to spar. I attempted to redirect him and he started to punch viscously at my head. I took him down to the mat and knelt on his chest, telling him to stop. Unfortunately, I had lightly "thumped" him on the forehead. He was not visually hurt. However, He

and his father had went to the ER and eventually pressed charges. I had to attend anger management classes and complete Probation.

Citation: 7/8/2008 Domestic Violence:

On July 8, 2008 my family and I were on vacation to an indoor water park out of state. While there, my son and I were swimming on and off throughout the day. My wife chose not to swim and to stay in the hotel room. Occasionally, my son and I would return to the hotel room for a break. It was at those times I would need to ask my wife to not discuss her planning our divorce while our son was in the room. Later that night after dinner she was talking to a friend, again saying things like "When I get back I am leaving Russ and he'll have to pay child support". I asked her to stop and end the conversation. I then took her phone. She grabbed our video camera, swinging it and smashing it against the wall. With my back to her I backed up managing to wrestle the camera away from her. She then ran out into the courtyard screaming very loudly. I followed her attempting to quiet her and to help her from the ground and back into the hotel room. The hotel staff and Sandusky Police were notified. They had said someone needs to be arrested to ensure the peace. I had agreed, although I thought the charges would've been disturbing the peace. I did not strike her. I did not obtain a lawyer to reduce the charges. I simply wanted to work on our marriage and move on. I had to attend anger management classes and pay a fine.

Citation: 7/4, 2007 Public Drunkenness/Similar Conduct:

On July 4, 2007 my wife and I were attending her fathers' birthday and Fourth of July celebration. After arriving at approximately 1 pm, we had started to play a horseshoe throwing type game. I had consumed 3-4 12 oz. beers and at approximately 5 pm I became very dizzy, overheated, nauseated and needed to sit down. My coordination and equilibrium was severely compromised and was unable to walk. I had sat drinking water and eating dinner, for the next 4-5 hours, until I felt better. At approximately 9 pm my brother-in-law received a call from his fathers' wife saying that his father was arrested for DUI after they left to go watch the fireworks. The Erie Police were called due to the brother-in-law making a disturbance, yelling and such. About an hour later, as I was attempting to leave. I was exiting through the garage and stumbled into

a cabinet, causing my brother-in-law to push me. I fell into the wall cutting my forehead. Again Erie Police were called due to his screaming. I was cited and released to receive medical treatment for the laceration. I had to pay a fine.

Citation: 3/18, 2007 Disorderly Conduct/Obscene Language/Gesture:

On March 8, 2007 my wife and I had attended the Philharmonic Orchestra and dinner that evening. After, we had decided to end the night with a cocktail and be home early to relieve the babysitter. It was approximately 11:30 pm and we were finishing our drink. At that time someone had spoken to my wife and a few minutes later she went and sat with him and his friend. I went to her and said I will bring the car around to the front and to meet me there. I had called her on her cell phone and at that time she had said she was staying there. I had attempted to reenter the establishment and was refused reentry. I was standing in front trying to reason with her. The Erie Police was called and as my wife and her friend were leaving and getting into a limousine I was trying to talk to my wife when the police officer had warned me not to curse. I don't recall cursing at her and as the limo was pulling off the police officer arrested me. I had to pay a fine.
