STIPULATION AND ORDER AS TO RESPONDENTS CVS PHARMACY AND YUN EUN, RPH ONLY

- J. David Wuest, in his official capacity as Executive Secretary of the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy, by and through its Assistant General Counsel, Peter K. Keegan, Esq., and Respondents, CVS Pharmacy #10861 ("CVS"), Pharmacy License No. PH03798, and Respondent Yuna Eun, RPh ("Eun"), Certificate of Registration No. 19627, **HEREBY STIPULATE AND AGREE THAT**:
 - 1. The Board has jurisdiction over Respondents and these matters.
- 2. On or about August 31, 2022, Board Staff served Respondents CVS, and Eun with the Notice of Intended Action and Accusation ("Accusation") on file in this matter together with the Statement to Respondents and Notice of Hearing.
- 3. Respondents, in lieu of filing an Answer, submit this Stipulation and Order for the Board's consideration.
- 4. Respondents are aware of the right to seek the advice of counsel in this matter and obtained the advice of counsel prior to entering this Stipulation.
- 5. Respondents are aware of the right to a hearing on the matters alleged in the Accusation, their right to reconsideration, their right to appeal, and any and all other rights which may be accorded pursuant to NRS Chapter 233B, Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, NRS Chapter 622A, Administrative Procedure Before Certain Regulatory Bodies, and NRS Chapter 639, Nevada Pharmacy Act.

- 6. Conditioned on the acceptance of this Stipulation by the Board, and with the exception of the right to challenge any determination that Respondents, or any of them, have failed to comply with the provisions of this Stipulation, Respondents hereby freely and voluntarily waive their rights to a hearing, reconsideration, appeal and any and all other rights related to this action that may be accorded to them by NRS Chapter 233B, Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, NRS Chapter 622A, Administrative Procedure Before Certain Regulatory Bodies, and NRS Chapter 639, Nevada Pharmacy Act.
- 7. Respondents admit that evidence exists, and that Board's staff prosecuting this case could present such evidence at an administrative hearing, to establish a factual basis for certain of the violations alleged in the Accusation, that:
 - A. Respondent To engaged in unprofessional conduct when she failed entered the prescription data correctly, therefore failed to strictly follow the instructions of the prescribing practitioner N.H. to fill **trazodone** instead of the incorrect medication **tramadol**, prescription number 109100, in violation of NAC 639.945(1)(d) and (i).
 - B. Respondent Eun engaged in unprofessional conduct when she failed to recognize the incorrect filling of the prescription pursuant to the instructions of the prescribing practitioner upon data entry verification, DUR, and final verification resulting in the sale of tramadol instead of the correct prescribed medication trazodone, failed to provide counseling to patient E.R., did not document if counseling was provided or refused in violation of NAC 639.707(1), (2), and (6)(b), NAC 639.945(1)(d) and (i).
 - C. Respondent CVS is responsible for the violations as the pharmacy where the violations alleged herein occurred pursuant to NAC 639.702 and NAC 639.945(2).
- 8. These violations are plead with particularity in the Accusation, and are grounds for disciplinary action against Respondents pursuant to NRS 639.210 and/or NRS 639.255.
- 9. In order to resolve this matter without incurring any further costs or the expense associated with a hearing, the Board and Respondent Eun, Certificate of Registration No. 19627, stipulate to the following penalties and/or conditions:

- A. Respondent Eun shall pay a fine of One-Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for the violations; and
- B. Respondent Eun shall pay Five-Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to partially reimburse the Board for recoverable attorney's fees and investigative costs.
- 10. In order to resolve this matter without incurring any further costs or the expense associated with a hearing, the Board and Respondent CVS, Pharmacy License No. PH03798 stipulate to the following penalties and/or conditions:
 - A. Respondent CVS shall pay a fine of Two-Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for the violations; and
 - B. Respondent CVS shall pay One-Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) to partially reimburse the Board for recoverable attorney's fees and investigative costs.
- 11. Any failure by any Respondent to comply with the terms of this Order may result in issuance by the Executive Secretary of an order to show cause pursuant to NAC 639.965 directing the non-compliant Respondent(s) to appear before the Board at the next regularly-scheduled meeting for a show cause hearing. If such a hearing results in a finding of a violation of this Order by any Respondent, the Board may impose additional discipline upon the non-compliant Respondent(s) consistent with the provisions of NRS Chapter 639.
- 12. General Counsel will present this Stipulation to the Board for approval pursuant to NRS 622.330 at the Board's regularly scheduled public meeting on January 11, 2023. Respondents will appear in person at the meeting to answer questions from the Board Members and/or Board Staff. The Board Members and Staff may discuss and deliberate regarding this Stipulation, even if Respondents or counsel are not present at the meeting.
- 13. The Board has discretion to accept this Stipulation, but it is not obligated to do so. If this Stipulation is approved by the Board, it shall be a public record pursuant to NRS 622.330 and shall be reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank pursuant to 42 USC § 1396r–2 and 45 CFR Part 60.
- 14. If the Board rejects any part or all of this Stipulation, and unless they reach an alternative agreement on the record during the hearing, the parties agree that a full hearing on the

merits of this matter may be heard by the Board on the same day or at a later date. The terms and admissions herein may not be used or referred to in a full hearing on the merits of this matter.

- 15. Upon approval of this Stipulation by the Board, Respondents shall pay the fines agreed to herein by *personal check, business check, cashier's check* or *certified check* or *money order* made payable to "State of Nevada, Office of the Treasurer," to be received by the Board's Reno office located at 985 Damonte Ranch Parkway Suite 206, Reno, Nevada 89521, within thirty (30) days of entry of this Order.
- 16. Upon approval of this Stipulation by the Board, Respondents shall pay the attorney's fees and investigative costs agreed to herein by *personal check, business check, cashier's check* or *certified check* or *money order* made payable to "Nevada State Board of Pharmacy," to be received by the Board's Reno office located at 985 Damonte Ranch Parkway Suite 206, Reno, Nevada 89521, within thirty (30) days of entry of this Order.
- 17. Subject to the approval of this Stipulation by the Board, the Board and Respondents agree to release one another from any and all additional claims arising from the facts set forth in the Accusation on file herein, whether known or unknown that might otherwise have existed on or before the effective date of this Order.

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Respondents have fully considered the charges and allegations contained in the *Notice of Intended Action and Accusation* in this matter, and the terms of this Stipulation, and have freely and voluntarily agreed to the terms set forth herein, and waived certain rights, as stated herein.

- J. David Wuest, in his official capacity as Executive Secretary of the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy, by and through its Assistant General Counsel, Peter K. Keegan, Esq., and Respondents Walgreens Pharmacy #4854 ("Walgreens"), Pharmacy License No. PH01293, and Respondent Minhquang D. Nguyen, RPh ("Nguyen"), Certificate of Registration No. 15913, jointly by and through counsel, William Stilling, Esq. of Stilling & Harrison, HEREBY
- STIPULATE AND AGREE THAT:
 - 1. The Board has jurisdiction over Respondents and these matters.
- 2. Respondent Nguyen has entered into two (2) prior stipulations for discipline before the Board. In April of 2013, Respondent Nguyen, as the Managing Pharmacist of Kmart #3719, stipulated in case no. 13-006, to a public letter of reprimand and a \$500.00 fine, for failing to verify the license status of each pharmacy employee in his charge. In October of 2022, Respondent Nguyen, as the managing pharmacist at Walgreens #7864, stipulated in case no. 18-055-RPH-A-S, to pay a fine of \$1,000.00, attorney's fees of \$500.00, and to complete two additional hours of continuing education regarding proper dispensing practices and/or medication review. As part of the stipulation in case no. 18-055-RPH-A-S, Respondent Nguyen admitted evidence existed to demonstrate he failed to accurately verify a medication at data entry review and dispensed a duplicated and mislabeled prescription, which constituted unprofessional conduct.

- 3. On or about October 14, 2022, Board Staff served Respondents Walgreens, and Nguyen with the Notice of Intended Action and Accusation ("Accusation") on file in this matter together with the Statement to Respondents and Notice of Hearing.
- 4. In lieu of filing an Answer through commonly retained counsel, William Stilling, Esq., this Stipulation and Order is being submitted for the Board's consideration.
- 5. Respondents are aware of the right to seek the advice of counsel in this matter and obtained the advice of counsel prior to entering this Stipulation.
- 6. Respondents are aware of the right to a hearing on the matters alleged in the Accusation, their right to reconsideration, their right to appeal, and any and all other rights which may be accorded pursuant to NRS Chapter 233B, Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, NRS Chapter 622A, Administrative Procedure Before Certain Regulatory Bodies, and NRS Chapter 639, Nevada Pharmacy Act.
- 7. Conditioned on the acceptance of this Stipulation by the Board, and with the exception of the right to challenge any determination that Respondents, or any of them, have failed to comply with the provisions of this Stipulation, Respondents hereby freely and voluntarily waive their rights to a hearing, reconsideration, appeal and any and all other rights related to this action that may be accorded to them by NRS Chapter 233B, Nevada Administrative Procedure Act, NRS Chapter 622A, Administrative Procedure Before Certain Regulatory Bodies, and NRS Chapter 639, Nevada Pharmacy Act.
- 8. Respondents admit that evidence exists, and that Board's staff prosecuting this case could present such evidence at an administrative hearing, to establish a factual basis for certain of the violations alleged in the Accusation, that:
 - A. Respondent Nguyen engaged in unprofessional conduct and conduct contrary to the public interest in violation of NAC 639.945(1)(i) and performed his duties in an incompetent, unskillful or negligent manner when he failed to separate, and clear inventory of expired medications or adulterated drugs in violation of NRS 585.370, NAC 639.601.

- B. Respondent Nguyen engaged in unprofessional conduct and conduct contrary to the public interest in violation of NAC 639.945(1) when he misrepresented to the Board's inspector that the expired medications were properly disposed when they were not.
- C. As the pharmacy/pharmacy owner at which the violations of law alleged herein occurred, Walgreens is responsible for those violations, including those of the pharmacy's employees, pursuant to NRS 639.230, NAC 639.702, and/or NAC 639.945(2).
- 9. These violations are pled with particularity in the Accusation, and are grounds for disciplinary action against Respondents pursuant to NRS 639.210 and/or NRS 639.255.
- 10. In order to resolve this matter without incurring any further costs or the expense associated with a hearing, the Board and Respondent Nguyen's, Certificate of Registration No. 15913, is hereby suspended. However, the suspension is immediately stayed. Respondent Nguyen shall be placed on probation for one (1) year from the date of entry of the Order. During the 1-year probationary period, Respondent Nguyen shall not violate any federal or state law pertaining to the dispensing of controlled substances and/or dangerous drugs. If Respondent Nguyen successfully completes the conditions of the probationary period, then after 1 year, Respondent's Certificate of Registration No. 15913 shall be fully restored. In addition, Respondent Nguyen agrees to stipulate to the following penalties and/or conditions:
 - A. Respondent Nguyen shall pay a fine of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) for the violations; and
 - B. Respondent Nguyen shall pay One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) to partially reimburse the Board for recoverable attorney's fees and investigative costs.
- 11. In order to resolve this matter without incurring any further costs or the expense associated with a hearing, the Board and Respondent Walgreens, Pharmacy License No. PH01293 stipulate to the following penalties and/or conditions:
 - A. Respondent Walgreens shall pay a fine of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for the violations; and

- B. Respondent Walgreens shall pay One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) to partially reimburse the Board for recoverable attorney's fees and investigative costs.
- 12. Any failure by any Respondent to comply with the terms of this Order may result in issuance by the Executive Secretary of an order to show cause pursuant to NAC 639.965 directing the non-compliant Respondent(s) to appear before the Board at the next regularly scheduled meeting for a show cause hearing. If such a hearing results in a finding of a violation of this Order by any Respondent, the Board may impose additional discipline upon the non-compliant Respondent(s) consistent with the provisions of NRS Chapter 639.
- 13. The Board's Assistant General Counsel will present this Stipulation to the Board for approval pursuant to NRS 622.330 at the Board's regularly scheduled public meeting on January 11, 2023. Respondents will appear in person at the meeting to answer questions from the Board Members and/or Board Staff. The Board Members and Staff may discuss and deliberate regarding this Stipulation, even if Respondents or counsel are not present at the meeting.
- 14. The Board has discretion to accept this Stipulation, but it is not obligated to do so. If this Stipulation is approved by the Board, it shall be a public record pursuant to NRS 622.330 and shall be reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank pursuant to 42 USC § 1396r–2 and 45 CFR Part 60.
- 15. If the Board rejects any part or all of this Stipulation, and unless they reach an alternative agreement on the record during the hearing, the parties agree that a full hearing on the merits of this matter may be heard by the Board on the same day or at a later date. STIPULATION AND ORDER

Brett Kandt, General Counsel for Petitioner the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy (Board), and Respondent Julio Garcia, MD, Certificate of Registration No. CS04711, by and through counsel, John A. Hunt, Esq., **HEREBY STIPULATE AND AGREE THAT**:

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction over Respondent and this matter.
- On or about October 11, 2022, Respondent was served with the Notice of
 Intended Action and Accusation (Accusation) on file in this matter together with the Statement to
 Respondent and Notice of Hearing.
- 3. On or about October 26, 2022, Respondent filed an Answer and Notice of Defense to the Accusation.
- 4. Respondent is fully aware of the right to seek the advice of counsel in this matter and obtained the advice of counsel prior to entering into this Stipulation.
- 5. Respondent is aware of the right to a hearing on the matters alleged in the Accusation, the right to reconsideration, the right to appeal and any and all other rights which may be accorded to him pursuant to NRS Chapter 233B (Nevada Administrative Procedure Act), NRS Chapter 622A (Administrative Procedure Before Certain Regulatory Bodies), and NRS Chapter 639 (Nevada Pharmacy Act).

- 6. Conditioned on the acceptance of this Stipulation by the Board, and with the exception of the right to challenge any determination that Respondent has failed to comply with the provisions of this Stipulation, Respondent hereby freely and voluntarily waives his rights to a hearing, reconsideration, appeal and any and all other rights related to this action that may be accorded to him by NRS Chapter 233B (Nevada Administrative Procedure Act), NRS Chapter 622A (Administrative Procedure Before Certain Regulatory Bodies), and NRS Chapter 639 (Nevada Pharmacy Act).
- 7. Respondent admits that evidence exists, and that Board staff prosecuting this case could present such evidence at an administrative hearing, to establish a factual basis for the violations alleged in the Accusation, *to wit*:
- A. On or about June 10, 2022, the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners (NSBME) entered an order in Case No. 22-9968-1, and imposed discipline on Respondent's License No. 5672 to practice medicine arising from Respondent's conduct as medical director of Image Med Spa;
- B. As further detailed in the NSBME's order in Case No. 22-9968-1, Respondent, whether knowingly or otherwise, permitted Skyler Pearson and Justin Hockett, the owners of Image Med Spa, to act under his authority as a practitioner to unlawfully operate Image and to purchase, access, store, possess, administer, furnish and/or dispense dangerous drugs and hypodermic devices, specifically to perform cosmetic injections and topical administration of dangerous drugs on-site to patients who had not been examined by a practitioner and without direct practitioner supervision, in violation of NRS 454.213(1), NRS 454.217, NRS 454.221, NRS 454.311, NRS 454.316, NRS 454.321, NRS 454.356, NRS 454.480, NRS 454.510, NRS 454.530, NRS 639.100(1), NRS 639.23505, NRS 639.281(1), NRS 639.282(1)(d), NAC 639.601(1), NAC 639.742, NAC.639.745 and/or NAC 639.898(1);

- C. Some of the drug products and devices purchased, accessed, stored, possessed, administered, furnished and/or dispensed at Image Med Spa are intended for distribution in foreign markets and are not approved for marketing, distribution or use in the U.S., in violation of 21 U.S.C. § 331, 21 U.S.C. § 355(a), NRS 454.351(1) and/or NRS 585.490; and
- D. By his actions and/or omissions, Respondent has engaged in unprofessional conduct as defined in NAC 639.945(1)(g), (h), (i), (j), (k) and/or (n), and has committed acts that render his registration inconsistent with the public interest pursuant to NRS 453.231.
- 8. Those violations are plead with particularity in the Accusation, and are grounds for action pursuant to NRS 453.236(1), NRS 453.241(1), NRS 639.210 and/or NRS 639.255.
- 9. To resolve this matter without incurring any further costs or the expense associated with a hearing, the Board and Respondent stipulate to the following penalties. The registration of Respondent Julio Garcia, MD, Certificate of Registration No. CS04711, is suspended for a period of one (1) year pursuant to NRS 453.241(1)(a). The suspension is stayed, and Respondent is placed on probation subject to the following conditions:
- A. Respondent shall accept this Stipulation and Order as a public reprimand for the violations;
- B. Respondent shall pay a fine of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) for the violations by personal, business, certified or cashier's check or money order made payable to "State of Nevada, Office of the Treasurer," to be received by the Board's Reno office located at 985 Damonte Ranch Parkway Suite 206, Reno, Nevada 89521, within thirty (30) days of entry of this Order; and
- C. Respondent shall pay One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) to partially reimburse the Board for reasonable attorney's fees and recoverable costs incurred in

investigating and prosecuting this matter, by personal, business, certified or cashier's check or money order made payable to the "Nevada State Board of Pharmacy" to be received by the Board's Reno office located at 985 Damonte Ranch Parkway – Suite 206, Reno, Nevada 89521, within thirty (30) days of entry of this Order.

Upon successful completion of probation, Respondent's Certificate of Registration No. CS04711 will be fully restored.

- 10. Any failure by Respondent to comply with the terms of this Order may result in issuance by the Executive Secretary of an order to show cause pursuant to NAC 639.965 directing Respondent to appear before the Board at the next regularly scheduled meeting for a show cause hearing. If such a hearing results in a finding of a violation of this Order by Respondent, the Board may impose additional discipline upon Respondent not inconsistent with the provisions of NRS Chapters 453 and 639.
- 11. General Counsel will present this Stipulation to the Board for approval pursuant to NRS 622.330 at the Board's regularly scheduled public meeting on January 11, 2023. Respondent will appear at the meeting to answer questions from the Board Members and/or Board Staff. The Board Members and Staff may discuss and deliberate regarding this Stipulation, even if Respondent is not present at the meeting.
- 12. The Board has discretion to accept this Stipulation, but it is not obligated to do so. That Alyza Lorraine Ventura is guilty of the crime of Driving Under the Influence Resulting in Substantial Bodily Harm, a violation of NRS 484C.430, NRS 484B.200 and NRS 0.060, a category B felony, as charged in the Information. 2. That Alyza Lorraine Ventura be punished by imprisonment in the Nevada State Prison for a minimum term of 24 months to a maximum term of 60 months, with credit for time served in the amount of 23 days. and by imposition of a fine in the amount of \$2,000.00. 3. It is further ordered that pursuant to NRS 484C.040 and 484C.460, prior to any reinstatement of driving privileges, Alyza Lorraine Ventura shall have an interlocking device installed and inspected on her vehicle at her expense for a period of 12 months, as set forth in NRS 484C.450, in any vehicle she owns or operates; said period to commence after any period of imprisonment, residential confinement, confinement in a treatment facility, or on parole or probation. 4. It is further ordered that Alyza Lorraine Ventura shall pay an administrative assessment fee of \$25.00, the \$3.00 administrative assessment for obtaining a biological specimen and conducting a genetic marker analysis, a \$150.00 DNA testing fee, and submit to a DNA analysis to determine the presence of genetic markers and a chemical analysis fee of \$60.00. 5. 

The Defendant entered a plea of guilty on March 23, 2107, and no legal cause being shown as to why judgment should not be pronounced against her, the Court rendered judgment as follows:

- That Alyza Lorraine Ventura is guilty of the crime of Driving Under the Influence Resulting in Substantial Bodily Harm, a violation of NRS 484C.430, NRS 484B.200 and NRS 0.060, a category B felony, as charged in the Information.
- 2. That Alyza Lorraine Ventura be punished by imprisonment in the Nevada State Prison for a minimum term of 24 months to a maximum term of 60 months, with credit for time served in the amount of 23 days, and by imposition of a fine in the amount of \$2,000.00.

It is further ordered that Alyza Lorraine Ventura shall pay an administrative assessment fee of \$25.00, the \$3.00 administrative assessment for obtaining a biological specimen and conducting a genetic marker analysis, a \$150.00 DNA testing fee, and submit to a DNA analysis to determine the presence of genetic markers and a chemical analysis fee of \$60.00.

Any fine, fee or administrative assessment imposed today (as reflected this judgment of conviction) constitutes a lien, as defined in Nevada Revised Statute 176.275. Should you not pay these fines, fees, or assessments, collection efforts may be undertaken against you.

Hello Mr. Keegan,

Yes I would like to seek dismissal of this case. I can call you, I live in Florida.

Thank you for the opportunity to present supporting documents to you in defense of my innocent position. I was, in fact, the pharmacist at my former employer, a non-resident pharmacy called Complete Pharmacy, located in Florida, however, the facility was not conducting any business into the State of Nevada.

Complete pharmacy was a FDA registered 503B outsourcing facility and was not conducting business as a pharmacy but rather as an outsourcing facility. According to the FDA and in our resident state of Florida, in a 503B outsourcing facility, the Pharmacist has not legal authority or jurisdiction over any quality related matters of the pharmacy. A 503B facility is considered a manufacturer, under GMP regulations, and the leading authority in the facility is the Quality Assurance Director and the Quality Control Department NOT the Pharmacist. This is the same law that the Florida board of pharmacy has for Florida pharmacies who operate as a registered 503B Outsourcing facility and not a pharmacy. A Pharmacist or PIC cannot even supervise quality control staff members and the Pharmacist cannot approve, oversee or conduct corrective actions for any quality related issues in a 503B outsourcing facility. The Florida Board of Pharmacy law requires that these duties are required to be done by the Quality Assurance Director and the Quality Control Department team. And this has to be an Independent Quality Control Unit function.

As the Pharmacist, I did make serious and urgent recommendations to correct all of the deficiencies that were noted in the inspection but I had no authority to mandate any changes or corrections related to those quality issues in the facility. This is exactly how many of my fellow pharmacist colleagues get into stressful situations like this with their respective boards of pharmacy because the State and Federal pharmacy laws mandate responsibilities and authority to Quality Assurance Director and Quality Control Department and NOT the pharmacist. In a traditional 503A compounding pharmacy, the pharmacist has fully authority and supervision over quality related facility matters and medication batch record release,

however, in a 503B outsourcing facility, the Quality Assurance Director and Quality Control Department team has full authority and supervision over all quality related matters and medication batch record release. In a 503B outsourcing facility (which dispenses office-stock medications, not patient-specific prescriptions), the pharmacist cannot give final batch release approval of medications and is legally only responsible for the receipt and possession of drugs in the facility and supervising the technician doing the compounding. Pharmacists are not even needed to dispense medications or check purchase orders, because 503B facilities do not process prescriptions. There is the huge disconnect as to the legal and responsibility function of a pharmacist working in a 503B outsourcing facility because Pharmacists don't have the traditional authority to mandate any changes or corrections related to any quality control related issues in the facility. The harsh reality and issue is the fact that the Quality Assurance Director and all of the Quality Assurance Team members do not hold any state licenses with the boards of pharmacy, so all of the legal responsibility falls back on the PIC, even those the PIC has no power or authority. Complete pharmacy had 1 Quality Assurance Director, 1 Quality Control Manager and 8 Quality Control technicians that are required by Florida Board of Pharmacy is act as an Independent Quality Control Unit. The Pharmacist are NOT allowed to be a part of the Quality Control Department with is not ethical or right because the Pharmacist are the only ones with the licenses with the boards of pharmacy and end up taking the a system the esblame. All of the allegations contained within the inspection as quality related matters and were under the direct supervision of the 10 member Quality Control Unit and I was not even legally able to be a decision maker to make any corrective actions changes related to these quality assurance matters.

VVVIS

Below is proof that Florida Board of Pharmacy Law does not give any authority to the pharmacist within a 503B Outsourcing facility.

503b - Outsourcing Inspection Quality - 21CFR part 211 subpart B (Florida)

- 1- Firm has an independent Quality Control Unit.
- 2- The QC unit has the authority and responsibility to approve or reject all components, drug product containers or closures, end process materials, packaging materials, labeling and drug products.
- 3- QC unit reviews and approves/rejects: SOP's, Batch Records (completeness and accuracy, components, API's, materials, OOS results).
- 4- QC unit reviews production records to assure that no errors have occurred, or if errors have occurred, that they have been fully investigated.
- 5- Adequate laboratory facilities for the testing and approval (or rejection) of components, drug product containers, closures, packaging materials, in-process materials, and drug products are available to the quality control unit.
- 6- The quality unit approves or rejects all procedures or specifications impacting the

identity, strength, quality, and purity of the drug product.

- 7- The responsibilities and procedures applicable to the QC unit are in writing and such procedures are followed.
- 8- QC unit personnel are qualified through training and experience

IN SUMMARY

I have been a honest and hard-working pharmacist for 17 years without any previous complaints from any board of pharmacy. Yes, I was previously employed by Complete Pharmacy, an FDA 503B registered outsourcing facility, for 8 years without prior incident. The company had a full team of 10 Quality Assurance employees that had full legal FDA authority of the deficiencies noted in the inspection. Under FDA outsourcing facility laws, the pharmacist have zero authority or supervision over Quality Assurance employees and/or Quality control management team, yet the board of pharmacy holds the PIC to be fully legally responsible without any power. I assumed the Pharmacist responsibilities not knowing how powerless the PIC is when employed in a 503B outsourcing facility and I am dearly paying the price for it years later. The inspection occurred 3.5 years ago. The pharmacy is now bankrupt and has been shut down for almost 4years now, and I quit the pharmacy due to do my lack of authority, poor employee treatment and lack of salary payments.

Please allow me to continue serving the patient community and helping to improve the quality of health care to those in need. Lessons have been learned, retraining has begun, and accountability is now noted. Once again, Complete pharmacy has not conducted any business in Nevada. I also never plan to utilize my Nevada pharmacist license and will not seek renewal once it expires.

I have learned my lesson and have sense gotten legal advice on how to handle the situation so that this doesn't happen again. I've gotten myself caught up in an incident that could potentially mess up my life. No matter what I am so excited to jump start my career in Pharmacy and continue my education. My intentions are to create a beautiful life and make my family proud. I intend on living up to that expectation, because I am not my friends and I have learned my lessons.
