STIPULATION AND ORDER

Brett Kandt, General Counsel for Petitioner the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy (Board), and Respondent Chad Hall, DO, Certificate of Registration No. CS20510, by and through counsel, Michael Sanft, Esq., **HEREBY STIPULATE AND AGREE THAT**:

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction over Respondent and this matter.
- 2. On or about September 29, 2021, Respondent was served with the Notice of Intended Action and Accusation (Accusation) on file in this matter together with the Statement to Respondent and Notice of Hearing.
- 3. Respondent is fully aware of the right to file an Answer and Notice of Defense to the Accusation prior to entering into this Stipulation.
- 4. Respondent is fully aware of the right to seek the advice of counsel in this matter and obtained the advice of counsel prior to entering into this Stipulation.
- 5. Respondent is aware of the right to a hearing on the matters alleged in the Accusation, the right to reconsideration, the right to appeal and any and all other rights which may be accorded to him pursuant to NRS Chapter 233B (Nevada Administrative Procedure Act), NRS Chapter 622A

(Administrative Procedure Before Certain Regulatory Bodies), and NRS Chapter 639 (Nevada Pharmacy Act).

- 6. Conditioned on the acceptance of this Stipulation by the Board, and with the exception of the right to challenge any determination that Respondent has failed to comply with the provisions of this Stipulation, Respondent hereby freely and voluntarily waives his rights to a hearing, reconsideration, appeal and any and all other rights related to this action that may be accorded to him by NRS Chapter 233B (Nevada Administrative Procedure Act), NRS Chapter 622A (Administrative Procedure Before Certain Regulatory Bodies), and NRS Chapter 639 (Nevada Pharmacy Act).
- Respondent does not contest the allegations in the Accusation, but acknowledges that Board staff prosecuting this case could present such evidence at an administrative hearing to establish a factual basis for the violations alleged in the Accusation, *to wit*, that by failing to disclose the charges in *United States vs. Chad Hall, DO, et al*, Case No. 2:19-cr-00154-RFB-VCF, to the Board on his renewal application for 2020, although he was subsequently acquitted on those charges, Respondent violated NRS 453.331(1)(e), NRS 453.231(1)(f) and/or NRS 453.236(1)(a), engaged in unprofessional conduct as defined in NAC 639.945(1)(h), and is subject to discipline pursuant to NRS 453.236(1), NRS 453.241(1), and/or NRS 639.210(4) and/or (10).
  - 8. Those violations are plead with particularity in the Accusation, and are grounds for action pursuant to NRS 453.236(1), NRS 453.241(1), NRS 639.210 and NRS 639.255.
  - 9. To resolve this matter without incurring any further costs or the expense associated with a hearing, the Board and Respondent Chad Hall, DO, Certificate of Registration No. CS20510, stipulate to the following penalties:
    - A. Respondent shall accept this Stipulation and Order as a public reprimand regarding his duties and responsibilities as a practitioner;

B. Pursuant to NRS 639.255(1)(f) and NAC 639.955(5), Respondent shall pay a fine of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), through monthly payments pursuant to the following schedule:

Respondent shall make the monthly payments of the fine amount by personal, business, certified or cashier's check or money order made payable to "State of Nevada, Office of the Treasurer," to be received by the Board's Reno office located at 985 Damonte Ranch Parkway – Suite 206, Reno, Nevada 89521. Respondent has the right to pre-pay any or all of the payments; and

- C. Pursuant to NRS 622.400, Respondent shall pay Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to partially reimburse the Board for reasonable attorney's fees and recoverable costs incurred in investigating and prosecuting this matter, by personal, business, certified or cashier's check or money order made payable to the "Nevada State Board of Pharmacy" to be received by the Board's Reno office located at 985 Damonte Ranch Parkway Suite 206, Reno, Nevada 89521, within thirty (30) days of entry of this Order.
- 10. Any failure by Respondent to comply with the terms of this Order may result in issuance by the Executive Secretary of an order to show cause pursuant to NAC 639.965 directing that Respondent to appear before the Board at the next regularly scheduled meeting for a show cause hearing. If such a hearing results in a finding of a violation of this Order by Respondent, the Board

may impose additional discipline upon Respondent consistent with the provisions of NRS Chapter 453 and/or Chapter 639.

- 11. General Counsel will present this Stipulation to the Board for approval pursuant to NRS 622.330 at the Board's regularly scheduled public meeting on March 8, 2023. Respondent will appear at the meeting to answer questions from the Board Members and/or Board Staff. The Board Members and Staff may discuss and deliberate regarding this Stipulation, even if Respondent is not present at the meeting.
- 12. The Board has discretion to accept this Stipulation, but it is not obligated to do so. If this Stipulation is approved by the Board, it shall be a public record pursuant to NRS 622.330 and shall be reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1396r–2 and 45 CFR Part 60.
- 13. If the Board rejects any part or all of this Stipulation, and unless they reach an alternative agreement on the record during the hearing, the parties agree that a full hearing on the merits of this matter may be heard by the Board. The terms and admissions herein may not be used or referred to in a full hearing on the merits of this matter.
- 14. Subject to the approval of this Stipulation by the Board, the Board and Respondent agree to release each other from any and all additional claims arising from the facts set forth in the Accusation on file herein, whether known or unknown that might otherwise have existed on or before the effective date of this Order.

Respondent has fully considered the charges and allegations contained in the *Notice of Intended* Action and Accusation in this matter, and the terms of this Stipulation, and has knowingly and voluntarily agreed to the terms set forth herein, and waived certain rights, as stated herein. **AGREED:** Signed this day of March, 2023 Signed this day of March, 2023 BRETT KANDT, ESQ. 

On Thursday, November 19, 2020, a hearing was held in the above matter before the Nevada State Board of Nursing ("Board") in compliance with the provisions of Chapters 233B and 632 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and Chapter 632 of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC).

Respondent Sage did not appear at the hearing. The Nevada State Board of Nursing appeared through counsel, Kimberly A. Arguello, Esq.

Based upon NAC 632.923, the Board proceeded to consider the case without the participation of Respondent. Documents were admitted into evidence. Pursuant to NAC 632.923, the Board considered the charges specified in the Complaint to be true. Accordingly, the Board made the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order:

### FINDINGS OF FACT

The Board, based upon evidence presented during the Hearing, finds that there is a preponderance of evidence in the record to establish each of the following findings of fact:

- 1. At least twenty-one (21) working days prior to the date of the hearing, Respondent had been noticed of the hearing by certified mail and by first class mail, which notice was mailed to Respondent's last known residential address.
  - 2. The Board found that proper notice of the hearing was given to Respondent.
- 3. The Board had jurisdiction over the matter, and the Board could proceed to make a determination in the matter.

- 4. On August 4, 2017, Respondent was granted a permanent Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) license in the State of Nevada.
- 5. On or about May 17, 2020, Respondent was employed and on duty as an LPN at the Humboldt General Hospital, located in Winnemucca, Nevada. On that day, during a routine pharmacy audit, a discrepancy was found involving oxycodone tablets. Respondent was asked to submit to a drug screen. Respondent's drug screen was positive for oxycodone.
- 6. Respondent contacted the Board and requested to voluntarily surrender her license.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 7. Based upon the above Findings of Fact, the Board hereby finds by a preponderance of the evidence the following violation of law:
- 8. The foregoing conduct constitutes grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to NRS 632.347(1)(g) unprofessional conduct, and NAC 632.890(10) when Respondent practiced nursing, if any amount of alcohol or a controlled substance or dangerous drug that is not legally prescribed is present in the body of the nurse, as determined by a test of the blood, saliva, breath, hair or urine of the nurse, given while the nurse is on duty.

### ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and good cause appearing therefore,

9. IT IS ORDERED that Respondent Sage's request for Voluntary Surrender of LPN license LPN17761 is accepted.

  - A. As of January 27, 2023, Respondent Dr. Thomson was no longer eligible to hold a Nevada certificate of registration to dispense controlled substances under NRS 639.2107 because she surrendered her Drug Enforcement Administration Registration for cause by executing a Form DEA-014;
  - B. Respondent Thomson diverted and self-administered controlled substances during work hours at Blue Pearl and is subject to discipline pursuant to NRS 453.226, NRS 453.236(1)(e), NRS 453.241(1), NRS 453.331(1)(d), NRS 453.336(1), NRS 453.381(2), NRS 453.411(1), NRS 639.210(4) pursuant to NAC 639.945(1), and NRS 639.255(3).
- 9. In order to resolve this matter without incurring any further costs or the expense associated with a hearing, the Board and Respondent Dr. Thomson stipulate to the following penalties and conditions.
  - A. Respondent Dr. Thomson's Certificate of Registration No. CS33508 shall be revoked for a period of 1 year. Respondent Dr. Thomson agrees that this one (1) year revocation

constitutes formal discipline pursuant to NRS 233B.121(6). The one (1) year revocation shall be measured from the effective date of the Board's Order accepting the Stipulation. Upon the expiration of the one (1) year revocation, and completion of the below stipulation terms, Respondent Dr. Thomson may petition the Board for reinstatement of Certificate of Registration No. CS33508;

- Respondent Dr. Thomson shall obtain an Evaluation for Substance Use Disorder and comply with any and all recommendations set forth by the Evaluator/Practitioner. The evaluation must be returned to the Board;
- ii. Pay a fine of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) for the alleged violations; and
- iii. Pay One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) to partially reimburse the Board for recoverable attorney's fees and costs incurred in investigating and prosecuting this matter.
- 10. Any failure by Respondent to comply with the terms of this Order may result in issuance by the Executive Secretary of an order to show cause pursuant to NAC 639.965 directing that Respondent to appear before the Board at the next regularly-scheduled meeting for a show cause hearing. If such a hearing results in a finding of a violation of this Order by Respondent Thomson, then the Board may impose discipline consistent with the provisions of NRS Chapter 639.
- General Counsel will present this Stipulation to the Board for approval pursuant to NRS 622.330 at the Board's regularly scheduled public meeting on March 8, 2023. Respondent Dr. Thomson will appear in person and/or with counsel at the meeting to answer questions from the Board Members and/or Board Staff. The Board Members and Staff may discuss and deliberate regarding this Stipulation, even if Respondent or counsel are not present at the meeting.
- 12. The Board has discretion to accept this Stipulation, but it is not obligated to do so. If this Stipulation is approved by the Board it shall be a public record pursuant to NRS 622.330 and shall be reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank pursuant to 42 USC § 1396r-2 and 45 CFR Part 60.

- 13. If the Board rejects any part or all of this Stipulation, and unless they reach an alternative agreement on the record during the hearing, the parties agree that a full hearing on the merits of this matter may be heard by the Board at a later date. The terms and admissions herein may not be used or referred to in a full hearing on the merits of this matter.
- 14. Upon approval of this Stipulation by the Board, Respondent shall pay the fines agreed to herein by personal check, business check, cashier's check or certified check or money order made payable to "State of Nevada, Office of the Treasurer," to be received by the Board's Reno office located at 985 Damonte Ranch Parkway Suite 206, Reno, Nevada 89521, within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Order.
- 15. Upon approval of this Stipulation by the Board, Respondent shall pay the attorney's fees and costs agreed to herein by personal check, business check, cashier's check or certified check or money order made payable to "Nevada State Board of Pharmacy," to be received by the Board's Reno office located at 985 Damonte Ranch Parkway Suite 206, Reno, Nevada 89521, within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Order.
- 16. Subject to the approval of this Stipulation by the Board, the Board and Respondent agree to release one another from any and all additional claims arising from the facts set forth in the Accusation on file herein, whether known or unknown that might otherwise have existed on or before the effective date of this Order.

Respondent has fully considered the charges and allegations contained in the *Notice of Intended Action and Accusation* in this matter, and the terms of this Stipulation, and have freely and voluntarily agreed to the terms set forth herein, and waived certain rights, as stated herein.
